IN-N-OUT BURGER®
OPENS IN SPANISH FORK, UTAH

IRVINE, CA – In 1948, Harry Snyder opened In-N-Out Burger, California's first "drive-thru" hamburger stand. Today, hamburgers are still made-to-order, shakes are still made with real ice cream, and In-N-Out Associates are still treated like family. Beginning October 29, 2020, In-N-Out hamburgers, shakes, and fries will be available at our newest location in Spanish Fork, Utah.

As with all locations, fresh ingredients will be supplied to the store from In-N-Out. Hamburger patties are made from 100% American beef and whole chucks are boned and ground by In-N-Out's own butchers. All patties are produced and delivered fresh throughout the week to the stores and are never frozen. French fries are made from fresh, whole potatoes and are hand diced.

Tessa Standerfer, who has been a veteran of In-N-Out for 18 years, will manage the new restaurant, located at 795 East 800 North. The restaurant will employ approximately 80 In-N-Out Burger Associates with a starting wage of \$13.50 per hour. There will be one drive-thru lane, a covered patio with outdoor seating for 30 guests, and indoor seating for 74 guests, although indoor seating is currently limited to allow for physical distancing. All In-N-Out Burger locations are open daily from 10:30 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. and until 1:30 a.m. on Friday and Saturday.

In-N-Out has locations throughout California, Nevada, Arizona, Utah, Texas, and Oregon. In-N-Out was founded by Harry and Esther Snyder and is still owned and operated by the Snyder family. None of the units are franchised.
