<u>IN-N-OUT BURGER®</u> OPENS IN ARVADA & PARKER, COLORADO

IRVINE, CA – In 1948, Harry Snyder opened the first In-N-Out Burger, a small $10' \times 10'$ drive-thru hamburger stand and introduced his newly developed two-way speaker box, which allowed guests to order without leaving their cars. Beginning September 5, 2024, In-N-Out hamburgers, shakes, and fries will be available at our two newest locations in Arvada and Parker, Colorado.

As with all locations, fresh ingredients will be supplied to the store from In-N-Out. Hamburger patties are made from 100% American beef, and whole chucks are boned and ground by In-N-Out's own butchers. All patties are produced and delivered fresh throughout the week to the stores and are never frozen. French fries are made from fresh, whole potatoes and are hand-diced.

Pat Campbell will manage the Arvada restaurant located at 7494 W. 52nd Avenue, and Stephanie Swartz will manage the Parker restaurant at 9558 Twenty Mile Road. Collectively, they have 47 years of experience with In-N-Out Burger (26 years for Pat and 21 years for Stephanie). Each location will employ approximately 80 In-N-Out Burger Associates with a starting wage of \$19.50 per hour. Both restaurants will have one drive-thru lane, indoor seating for 84 guests, and a covered patio with outdoor seating for 28 guests. All In-N-Out Burger locations are open daily from 10:30 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. and until 1:30 a.m. on Friday and Saturday.

In-N-Out has locations throughout California, Nevada, Arizona, Utah, Texas, Oregon, Colorado, and Idaho. In-N-Out was founded by Harry and Esther Snyder and is still owned and operated by the Snyder family. None of the units are franchised.
